Defects at birth, Deficiencies, Diseases, Development delays including disability.RBSK Programme at Baranagar Has been started since October 2015 under which Govt Sponsored or Aided School Childrens and also ICDS beneficiaries (6 Weeks to 6 years at ICDS Level and from 6 years to 18 years at School Level) are being screened by Medical officers(Ayush).48 Anganwadi (ICDS) Centers and Eight Scools has been covered so fer for this Screening Activity.
